



DESIGN FOR A BOMBING AIRPLANE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert J. Minshall, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Seattle, in the county of King and State of Washington, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bombing Airplane, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the airplane. Figure 2 is a front elevation, and Figure 3 is a side elevation of the airplane. Figure 4 is a three-quarters rear perspective view from slightly above, illustrating the airplane in flight.
