The Earl of Lichfield's Troop, commanded by Lt Colonel Gordon  
Sir Thomas Glemham's troop, commanded by Sir Henry Stradling  
General Charles Gerard's Horse 800 strong  
NOTE: This was actually a Brigade of Horse composed of regiments of  
Gerard's Army and including:  
Charles Gerard's Lifeguard of Horse  
Charles Gerard's Regiment of Horse  
Colonel Roger Whitley's Regiment of Horse,  
commanded by Lt Col. Bambrigg?

ex-Garrison of Welbeck House and incorporating the remnants of Thomas  
Wheatley's Regiment of Foot  
Colonel Harvey Bagot's Regiment of Foot 150 strong  
part only - ex-Garrison of Lichfield
