

**Organization of a German Light Division
1939**

Division Command

- Motorcycle messenger platoon
- Motorized Mapping Section
- Staff Schützenbrigade (Staff Infantry Brigade)
(1st Light Division Only)
- 1 Kavalerie Schützenregiment, (Mounted Infantry Regiment), with
 - 3 Kavalerie Schützenabteilungen (Mounted Infantry Battalions)
each with
 - 3 Schützenschwadron
 - 18 Light MG's
 - 2 Heavy MG's
 - 3 Light Trench Mortars
 - 1 Light Motorized Column
 - 1 Motorized Infantry Support Squadron
 - 8 Light Infantry Support Guns

(2nd & 4th Light Divs, each had 2 Kavalerie Schützenregiment(s), each of which had 2 Kavalerie Schützenabteilungen. Each "abteilung" had 3 Schützenschwadrons (18 LMG's, 4 HMG's & 3 Light Trench Mortars), 1 Heavy Squadron (4 Light Infantry Support Guns, 6 Medium Trench Mortars, & 3 Anti-tank Guns), and a Pioneer Platoon (3 LMG's).

 - 1 Motorcycle Squadron

 - 3 Heavy Armored Car Squadrons

- 3 Motorized Batteries, each with
 - 4 105mm Light Infantry Field Howitzers

Panzer Battalion, with

- 3 Light Panzer Companies
- 1 Detachment

 3 Motorized Anti-Tank Companies, each with
 12 Anti-tank Guns
 1 Motorized Heavy Machine Gun Company (not in 4th Lt. Div.)
 12 20mm Flak guns

 9 Light MG's
 1 Bridge Column K or B
