 - 1 rifle & 1 four seat light passenger vehicle
- 3 Wagon Drivers
 - 3 rifles, 6 horses & 3 two horse wagons
- 3 Groups:
 - 3 Group Leaders
 - 3 submachine guns
 - 27 Pioneers
 - 6 rifles, 3 pistols, 18 submachine guns
