 - 1 rifle & 1 bicycle
- 3 Groups:
 - 3 Group Leaders
 - 3 submachine guns & 3 bicycles
 - 24 Pioneers & Machine Gunners
 - 15 rifles, 6 pistols, 3 submachine guns, 3 light machine guns & 24 bicycles

Munitions, Equipment & Baggage Squad:

- 1 Weapons NCO/Squad Leader
 - 1 submachine gun
- 1 Equipment NCO
 - 1 rifle
- 1 Bicycle Repairman
 - 1 rifle
- 3 Truck Drivers (4th driver added later)
 - 3 rifles & 3 3ton trucks (later 4 of each)
