# Sturmgeschütz Battalion

Staff same as Panzer IV Battalion, but Staff company was reduced by 1 Sd Kfz 251/8, 1 Corpsman (NCO), 1 Corpsman (soldier), & 1 driver). The Panzer IV were replaced by Sturmgeschütz III 75mm StuK  $40\,(\text{L}/48)$  Sd Kfz 142/1 as command vehicles. The reconnaissance platoon was deleted, but the Reconnaissance/Pioneer Platoon and Flak Detachments were the same.

#### Tiger Battalion

Staff was the same. The staff company had the Panzer IV replaced by

the Tiger Sd Kfz 181 88mm KwK 36 (L/56) or the Tiger Sd Kfz 182 88mm KwK 43 (L/71). The Reconnaissance Platoon stood as follows:
