## Parliamentary Ordinance to Raise a Standing Army 12 July 1644

"...the several Counties, Cities, and Places, hereafter mentioned, shall, immediatley after the Receipt of this Ordinance, raise such Forces of Horse and Foot, well and sufficiently armed, as are heareafter particularly set down, to be ready to march the 20th Day of this present July, 1644; that is to say,"
