Notes:

On 12 June Duke Ferdinand formed the Maxwell Grenadier Battalion from grenadier companies of the English regiments. The Hanvoerian Grenadier Battalions Sydow and Pritzelwitz (and later Wense) were formed from the Hanoverian Grenadier Companies.

A grenadier corps was formed with these three battalions and the two Hessian (Donop and Schlotheim) and two Brunswick (Stammer and Witorff) under the command of Generalmajor Prinzen Karl von Braunschweig-Bevern.

Wangenheim formed a similar grenadier battalion (Wersebe).
