Rangers Formed to Defend the Western US Frontier 1790

Twenty-one ranger troops were ordered raised to serve from 1 March to 30 November. One troop was to be assigned to each of 21 counties along the Ohio and Cumberland settlements and the settlements upon and between the forks of the Holston and Frenc Broad Rivers.

Each Ranger troop consisted of:

- 1 Lieutenant
- 1 Sergeant
- 1 Corporal
- 12 Rangers
