\* The figures vary wildly on this formation. The national guard did fight on 30 April, but after that they were primarily a police force roaming the streets of Rome.

Hoffstetter, being a member of the inner Garibaldian circle and probably the third in command of the army, was in a better position to know than the other two sources. The total comes to 4,170 plus some 50 lancers.
