This unit is divided into three sections, each consisting of two guns. Six motorcycles with sidecars and one motor car (with box body) are provided for the service of each section, carrying gun detachments and ammunition as follows:

Each "A" motorcycle with sidecar carries gun, two men, and 1,250 rounds of small arms ammunition.

Each "B" motorcycle with sidecar carries two men and 3,000 rounds of small arms ammunition.

Each "C" motorcycle with sidecar carries a sergeant (or corporal), one man, and 1,500 rounds of ammunition.

Each motor car carries driver, spare man, and 10k,000 rounds of small arms ammunition, one motor car in each section carries a mechanic, in addition.
