ADDENDUM:

According to one source, the following movements occurred in 1944:

The III./KG40 moved to Garz 15 May 1944, to Rastken 29 May 1944, and back to Cognac 1 June 1944. The ground personnel remained at Cognac.

The Staff/,II./KG40 moved to Hexengrund 5 May 1944, and returned to France after 21 May 1944. The ground personnel remained in France.

The reasons for these movements are unknown, and are only supported by one source.

KAMPFGESCHWADER 50

I GRUPPE:

The I Gruppe was formed July 1942 in Brandenburg-Briest from parts of 10./KG40. It was equipped with He 177A bombers. The unit was charged with the evaluation of this new bomber, which took place at Brandenburg-Briest and at Värlo/se (Denmark).

In early December 1942 the unit was transferred to Zaporozhye in Southern Russia for winter trials with 20 He 177A. Due to the worsening situation at Stalingrad, the unit was promptly assigned to transport duty, although only seven aircraft was serviceable. On the first operation Gruppenkommandeur, Major Scheede, was lost, and the aircraft was found to be totally unsuited for the transport role. The unit quickly reverted to bombing missions in support of the Army. I./KG50 flew 13 missions, and lost most of its aircraft.

In late January 1943 the remnants of the gruppe returned to Brandenburg-Briest, and was retrained in an anti-shipping role using Hs 293 missiles. The unit moved to Burg-Magdeburg later in the year.

On 25 October 1943 the unit was redesignated II./KG40 and moved to Bordeaux-Merignac.
