2nd Guides Regiment:

- 2 Battalions, each with:
 - 3 (mot) Cavalry Squadrons (8 LMGs ea)
 - 1 Motorcycle Company (8 LMGs & 4 HMGs)
 - 1 (mot) Anti-tank Platoon (8 47mm AT guns)

4th Lancers Regiment:

- 2 Battalions, each with:
 - 3 (mot) Cavalry Squadrons (8 LMGs ea)
 - 1 Motorcycle Company (8 LMGs & 4 HMGs)
 - 1 (mot) Anti-tank Platoon (8 47mm AT guns)

3rd Chasseur à Cheval Regiment:

- 2 Battalions, each with:
 - 3 (mot) Cavalry Squadrons (8 LMGs ea)
 - 1 Motorcycle Company (8 LMGs & 4 HMGs)
 - 1 (mot) Anti-tank Platoon (8 47mm AT guns)

19th (?) Artillery Regiment:

- 1st & 2nd (mot) Battalions (2 btrys - 4 75mm guns ea)
- 3rd & 4th (mot) Battalions (3 btrys - 4 105mm howitzers ea)

Pioneer Battalion:

- 2 (mot) Engineer Companies

Signals Battalion:

- 1 (mot) Radio Company
- 1 (mot) Telephone Company

Armored Car Platoon (8 light armored cars)

Construction Regiment:

- 3 (mot) Battalions, each with 4 companies

Support Units:

- 1 (mot) Flak Company (24 20mm guns)
- 2 Transportation Companies
- 4 (mot) Munition Train Platoons
- 1 (mot) Engineer Train Platoon
- 1 (mot) Supply Train Platoons
- 1 (mot) Medical Company
- 2 (mot) Maintenance Companies

Total Weapons: 120 LMGs, 60 SMGs, 24 AT guns, 8 light armored cars, 16 75mm field guns, and 24 105mm howitzers.
