

**Organization of Italian Lybian Division
1940**

Division

- Divisional HQ
- 2 Infantry Regiments, each with
 - Regimental HQ
 - 3 Infantry Battalions
- 1 Engineering Battalion
- 1 AT Company, with
 - 8 47mm AT guns
- 1 Artillery Regiment
 - 2 Motorized AA Companies, each with
 - 8 20mm AA guns
 - 2 77mm Field Gun Battalions, each with
 - Battalion HQ
 - 3 77mm Batteries, each with
 - 4 75mm/28 Field Guns.

Note: Two of these divisions were raised. They had 237 officers, 174 NCO's, 460 Italian soldiers and 6,353 Lybian soldiers. They were armed with 216 LMG's and 66 HMG's.
