Soviet Baltic State Invasion Forces 15-16 & 21 June 1940

In June 1940 The Soviet Army High Command was ordered to prepare an offensive operation against Baltic States (Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia). Military operations were foreseen if these states refused to accept Soviet demands bringing them into the Soviet sphere of in-fluence. By 15-16 June 1940 the following forces were concentrated on their borders.

The Baltic states submmitted to the Soviet demands and the invasion was cancelled. Nevertheless, the Soviet armies entered Lithuanian, Latvian and Estonian territory. By 21 June 1940 the Soviet forces in Baltic States had a following composition:
