 - 2 Radio Operators
 - 2 rifles & 2 100ccm motorcycles
 - 2nd (mot) Portable Radio Troop (b):
 - same as 1st Troop
 - 3rd (mot) Portable Radio Troop (b):
 - same as 1st Troop

Ground Squad:

- Medium (mot) Radio Troop (b)
 - 1 Troop Leader (NCO)
 - 1 rifle
 - 7 Radio Operators
 - 7 rifles, one Kfz 2, one Kfz 15 & one Kfz 17
(all three are radio trucks)
 - 4th (mot) Portable Radio Troop (b):
 - included in totals of medium troop
- (mot) Light Radio Troop (a):
 - 1 Troop Leader (NCO)
 - 1 rifle
 - 7 Radio Operators
 - 7 radios, one Kfz 15 radio truck and 1 Kfz 17
radio truck

Baggage:

- 1 Truck Driver
 - 1 rifle & 1 medium truck
- 1 Assistant Truck Driver
 - 1 rifle
- 1 Motorcycle Messenger
 - 1 rifle & 1 350ccm motorcycle with sidecar
- 7 Mounted Horse Attendants
 - 11 horses, 3 pack horses, and 7 rifles
