 - 6 light & 3 heavy artillery batteries (100% mobile)

29th (mot) Infantry Division:

- 4 strong & 2 cut up infantry battalions (100% mobile)
- 1 medium strength engineer battalion (100% mobile)
- 5 Panzer II
- 20 Panzer III (long)
- 10 Panzer III (75mm gun)
- 14 Panzer IV (long)
 - 2 Command tanks

71st Infantry Division:

- 7 weak infantry battalions (100% mobile)
- 1 weak engineer battalion (80% mobile)
- 9 light batteries (29 guns, 73% mobile)
- 3 heavy batteries (7 guns, 70% mobile)

297th Infantry Division:

- 9 weak infantry battalions (100% mobile)
- 1 weak engineer battalion (100% mobile)

371st Infantry Division:

- 3 cut up & 5 weak infantry battalions

1st Rumanian Infantry Division:

- 1 medium strength, 5 cut up & 1 weak infantry battalions
- 9 76.2mm btrys
- 4 100mm howitzer btrys

2nd Rumanian Infantry Division:

- 1 strong & 6 cut up infantry battalions
- 9 75mm btrys (2 with 3 guns ea)
- 4 100mm howitzer btrys

4th Rumanian Infantry Division:

3 strong, 4 medium infantry battalions
1 strong engineer battalion
7 75mm btrys (2 with 3 guns ea)
4 100mm howitzer btrys

20th Rumanian Infantry Division:

7 strong infantry battalions
6 Light Batteries (76.2mm guns)
6 Heavy Batteries (100mm howitzers)
