4th Panzer Army
24 October 1942**

29th (mot) Infantry Division:

- 6 strong infantry battalions (100% mobile)
- 1 strong motorcycle battalion (100% mobile)
- 6 light & 3 heavy batteries (100% mobile)
- 2 heavy flak batteries (2 guns per battery) (100% mobile)
- 1 light flak battery (100% mobile)
- 1 strong engineer battalion (90% mobile)
- 5 Panzer II
- 23 Panzer III (long)
- 10 Panzer III (75mm)
- 14 Panzer IV (long)
- 2 Command tanks
- 9 Self Propelled Anti-Tank guns

20th Rumanian Infantry Division:

- 7 strong infantry battalions (75% mobile)
- 1 strong engineer battalions (75% mobile)
- 6 Light Batteries (76.2mm guns) (75% mobile)
- 6 Heavy Batteries (100mm howitzers) (75% mobile)

371st Infantry Division:

- 1 medium strength, 5 cut up & 1 weak infantry battalions (60% mobile)
- 1 cut up engineer battalion
- 6 light & 3 heavy batteries (each with 2 heavy howitzers)
- 2 werfer batteries (40% mobile) (lost 2 105mm, 3 150mm & 8 launchers since last report)

297th Infantry Division:

- 2 medium strength, 5 cut up infantry battalions (100% mobile)
- 1 weak engineer battalion (100% mobile)
- 1 weak engineer battalion
- 9 light & 3 heavy bateries (90% mobile)

Key:

- Strong over 400 men
- Medium over 300 men
- Cut up over 200 men
- Weak under 200 men
