4 100mm howitzer btrys (100% mobile)
29 medium PAK & 6 heavy PAK

4th Rumanian Infantry Division:

(90% mobile)
7 75mm btrys (2 with 3 guns ea) (90% mobile)
4 100mm howitzer btrys (two btrys equipped with Russian
76.2mm howitzers) (90% mobile)
1 strong pioneer battalion (100% mobile)
19 medium PAK & 4 heavy PAK

20th Rumanian Infantry Division:

7 strong infantry battalions (75% mobile)
1 cut up engineer battalions (75% mobile)
6 Light Batteries (76.2mm guns) (75% mobile)
6 Heavy Batteries (100mm howitzers) (75% mobile)
29 medium PAK & 5 heavy PAK
