- 12 medium PAK & 12 heavy PAK
- 6 Panzer II
- 7 Panzer III (long)
- 5 Panzer III (75mm)
- 2 Panzer IV (long)
- 6 76.2mm Self propelled AT guns
- 9 50mm PAK 38 AT guns
- 5 light artillery batteries (4 105mm howitzers) (100% mobile)
- 1 light artillery battery (1 105mm howitzer) (100% mobile)
- 3 heavy artillery batteries (one with 4 guns, one with 3 guns,
one with only personnel)
- 1 light flak battery (100% mobile)
- 1 heavy flak battery (only personnel)
