7 NCOs, 22 soldiers, 14 rifles, 15 pistols, 2 submachine guns, 1 light machine gun, 1 Kfz 1 light personnel vehicles, 6 other trucks, 1 Sd Kfz 251/8 ambulance half track, and 1 350ccm motorcycle with sidecar

Field Train II:

4 NCOs, 6 soldiers, 1 rifle, 9 pistols, 1 submachine gun, 1 light machine gun and 1 heavy truck.

Administration and Supply Squad:

2 warrant officers, 8 NCOs, 48 soldiers, 51 rifles, 7 pistols, 1 submachine gun, 1 light four seat passenger vehicle (volkswagen), 1 350ccm motorcycle & 23 trucks
