  - 1 rifle, 1 horse & 1 Jf 8 Infantry Cart
- 1 Cart (2 draft horses) for munitions and baggage
  - 3 Groups, with a total of:
    - 3 Group Leaders (NCOs)
      - 3 submachine guns
    - 27 Soldiers & Machine Gunners
      - 6 rifles, 18 submachine guns, 3 pistols & 3 light machine guns.
