Field Train:

1 warrant officer, 7 NCOs, 22 soldiers, 7 riding horses, 34 draft horses, 23 rifles, 7 pistols, 2 medical panjewagons, 2 blacksmith panjewagons, 3 equipment panjewagons, and 1 (six horse) Hf11 or Hf 13 field kitchen.

Gun Maintenance Troop:

1 warrant officer, 1 NCO, 8 soldiers, 2 riding horses, 12 draft horses, 6 rifles, 4 pistols, 3 panjewagons.

Administrative Baggage:

2 NCOs, 13 soldiers, 1 riding horses, 8 draft horses, 15 rifles, 4 1.5 ton trucks & 2 (4 horse) Panjewagons

Baggage:

1 NCO, 4 soldiers, 5 rifles, 1 1.5 ton truck
