  - 1 Telephone Troop Leader (NCO) (1 machine pistol)
  - 4 Telephone Operators (4 rifles, 2 Jf 8 carts & 1 draft horse)
- 2 Light Field Cable Troops 3, each with:
  - 9 Telephone Operators (2 machine pistol & 7 rifles)
  - 1 Jf8 Infantry Cart with horse
  - 1 Jf8 Infantry Cart
- 4 Portable Radio Troops:
  - 1 Radio Troop Leader (NCO) (1 machine pistol)
  - 8 Radio Operators (5 rifles & 3 machine pistol)
