Change #2 of 7 January 1944

Revised the Headquarters & Headquarters Company, changing the number of Technical Sergeants to 7, Staff Sergeants to 8, Sergeants to 12, Corporals to 9, Privates 1st Class to 60 and Privates to 24.

The rifle companies changed the number of Technical Sergeants to 4, Staff Sergeants to 21, Sergeants to 10, Corporals to 4, Privates 1st Class to 126 and Privates to 49.

Change #3 of 2 August 1944

Revised the Headquarters & Headquarters Company, changing the numbers of Tech Grade 4 to 10, Tech Grade 5 to 27, Privates 1st Class to 56 and Privates to 21. The number of M1 carbines went to 100.

Revised the rifle company, changing the number of Privates 1st Class up to 126 and the number of Privates down to 49.

The Medical Detachment did not change in strength, but did revise its structure in the ranks of its privates.

Change #4 of 9 September 1944

Revised the Headquarters & Headquarters Company, changing the number of Privates 1st Class to 58 and the number of Privates down to 22. The number of M1 carbines fell to 91 and the number of .45 cal submachine guns rose to 41. In addition the headquarters added 3 M7 medium tanks with 105mm howitzers.
