1944**

Does not include the 7th Armored Division, which was equipped with Cromwell tanks.

Total Strength: 37 officers & 655 men

Headquarters

- 4 Sherman tanks
- 1 half-track
- 1 command car

Signal Troop

- 3 15cwt trucks
- 1 3-ton truck

REME (Engineer) Detachment

- 3 15cwt trucks
- 1 half-track
- 2 3-ton trucks
- 2 Scrammel or Diamond tank transporters

HQ Squadron

- 2 jeeps
- 1 15 cwt truck

Administration Troop

- 8 motorcycles
- 6 jeeps
- 3 15cwt trucks
- 1 15cwt water carrier
- 3 Ambulance halftracks
- 2 workshop halftracks
- 16 3-ton trucks

Reconnaissance Troop

- 11 Stuart Tanks

Intercom Troop

- 9 Scout cars

Anti-aircraft Troop

- 8 Crusader AA tanks

3 Squadrons (A,B, & C), each with:

HQ

- 1 Jeep
- 2 Sherman Tanks
- 1 Sherman close support tank
- 1 Sherman recovery tank

Administration

- 3 Halftracks
- 1 15cwt truck
- 12 3-ton trucks

5 Troops, each with:

- 3 Sherman Tanks

The squadron was later revised to four troops of 4 Shermans and 1 firefly Sherman each. By 1945 this became two Sherman troops and two firefly troops per squadron.
