 - 2 rifles
- 1 Wagon Driver
- 1 Panjewagon for munition and baggage
 - 4 horses
- 1 Jf 8 Infantry Cart for munition and baggage (hand drawn)
 - 3 Groups, with a total of:
 - 3 Group Leaders (NCOs)
 - 3 submachine guns & 3 bicycles
 - 24 Riflemen and Gunners
 - 18 rifles, 3 pistols, 3 submachine guns, 4 light machine guns (1 reserve), 24 bicycles

 rifles, 1 pistol, 1 submachine gun, 1 light machine gun, 6 (later 5) Panjewagons,
 2 Jf8 Infantry carts, & 6 bicycles.
