

**Organization of a Finnish Infantry Brigade  
15 February 1944**

Brigade Staff: (313 men, 11 SMGs)

2 Cavalry Regiments, each with: (1,284 men)

- 1 Staff Squadron (13 SMGs)
- 4 Squadrons (9 LMGs, 2 HMGs, 2 50mm mortars & 44 SMGs)
- 1 Heavy Squadron (4 SMGs, 3 81mm mortars, 4 AT rifles, 15 SMGs)

2 Bicycle Battalions, each with: (834 men)

- 1 Staff Company (153 men, 3 81mm mortars, 10 SMGs)
- 3 Bicycle Companies (163 men, 48 SMGs, 2 AT rifles)
- 1 Heavy Bicycle Company (186 men, 14 SMGs, 12 HMGs, 4 AT rifles)

Anti-Tank Squadron: (117 men, 10 SMGs, & 6 37mm to 75mm AT guns)

(mot) Light Artillery Battalion: (487 men)

- (mot) Staff Battery (5 SMGs)
- (mot) Ammunition Column (1 SMG)
- 3 (mot) Howitzer Batteries (4 light howitzers & 8 SMGs)

Horse Battery:

- 1 Gun Battery (177 men, 6 light field mm guns, & 9 SMGs)

Supply Troops: (105 men & 1 SMG)

- 1 (mot) Munition Column
- 1 (mot) Supply Platoon
- 1 (mot) Platoon

Medical Troops: (90 men & 1 SMG)

- 1 (mot) Medical Platoon
- 1 (mot) Field Hospital Platoon

(mixed mobility) Veterinary Company: (68 men)

March Company: (19 men)

(replacement company)

Total Equipment:

806 SMGs, 72 LMGs, 48 SMGs, 15 50mm mortars, 12 81mm mortars, 28 AT rifles, 6 AT guns (37mm to 75mm guns), 6 light field guns, 12 light howitzers, 290 trucks, 27 motorcycles, 2, 429 horses, and 5,612 men.,

Note: The caliber of Finnish guns was not standardized.
