 - (of 3 platoons each with 3 groups)
 - (9 LMGs & 3 61mm mortars)
 - 1 Machine Gun company (8 HMGs,
 - 1 mortar platoon (with 81mm mortars)
- 1 AT Company (6-9 37mm or 45mm or 50mm AT guns)
- 1 Staff Company (1 mounted & 1 signals platoon)
- 1 Field Dressing Station

1 Artillery Regiment:²

- 1st Battalion (3 btrys, 4-50mm guns ea)
- 2nd Battalion (3 btrys, 4-100mm or 105mm guns ea)
- 3rd Battalion (3 btrys, 4-120mm mortars)
- 4th Battalion (3 btrys, 4-100mm or 105mm guns ea)
 - (Battery had 3/3/125-128 men)

1 AT Battery (6 guns of mixed caliber, mostly 50mm)
